Credit

Billing privileges will only be offered when anticipated billing exceeds \$10,000.00.

A 10% deposit will be required with the group's signed contract for all new business. The additional 40% will be required no later than 60 days prior to arrival. Once we establish the group with a 50% deposit, all future trips will also require a 50% deposit.

Completed credit applications are to be submitted to the Credit Department no more than 120 days prior to the group's arrival date and no later than 90 days prior to arrival. The company responsible for the billing must complete the credit application. Sales will add terms to the Third-Party Addendum that advises that Bellagio may request a credit application from the end user.

Sixty days out, the Credit Department will give Sales a credit decision. If additional monies are required above the 50%, Sales will advise the group of the total amount due at 60 days prior to arrival. Any questions regarding the credit decision will be referred to the Vice President of Credit Operations. If there are any changes to the estimated amount after credit has been approved, Sales and Catering must notify the Credit Department by memo prior to the group's arrival. Catering must also notify the Convention Service Manager when food and beverage arrangements increase over the original amount of credit.

For Groups booked between 90 and 30 days

- 50% deposit and credit application will be received with signed contract
- 30 days out, Credit department will give Sales a credit decision

A letter of credit may be required for large volume accounts. The Casino Controller will keep the Letter of Credit.

Company Checks will not be accepted less than 30 days prior to arrival for deposits. Anything under 30 days, company must send a wire transfer, cashier's check or use a credit card.

Deposit money will be collected on tangible items only. For example: rooms, food, show tickets, audiovisual, etc. Attrition charges will be estimated at 30 days prior to arrival and billing will be established to cover the estimated amount. The Sales Department will estimate the group's billing figure with a 10% buffer. The Credit Department will review each group for an additional 20% over the estimated billing in order to cover additional charges that occur while the group is in-house. Should the group's charges exceed the original estimated revenue and/or the approved billing amount, group will be required to pay this overage at the time of departure.

Groups should be instructed to send all deposit monies directly to the lockbox account for your property. This is so we are in compliance with Sarbanes-Oxley. Accounts Receivable will notify Sales/Catering and Credit of all deposits received.

Cash paid out against the master account is not to exceed \$5,000.00 for the duration of the program, with a maximum of \$2,500.00 per day. If the group requires a larger amount, it will need to wire monies ahead of arrival date or present a cashier's check upon arrival.

Any exceptions to the above policies must be approved by the Vice President of Credit Operations, Vice President of Hotel Sales & Marketing and/or the Chief Financial Officer or Vice President of Hotel Operations. These authorizations must be done in writing and sent to the Vice President of Credit Operations.

City ledger accounts

- Will only be processed with estimated yearly revenue of \$50,000.00

Convention Technical Services

Bellagio has its own in-house Audiovisual Department, which features state-of-the-art equipment and trained technicians. It is the policy of Bellagio that all audiovisual requests be directed through the Audiovisual Department.

Labor is charged on all audiovisual equipment, including engineering and special services. All audiovisual equipment set-up diagrams must be submitted no later than 45 days prior for functions of 300 or more (See Fire Marshal Regulations).

A price list for audiovisual equipment including flip charts, microphones, etc. can be obtained from your Convention Services Manager or by contacting the Audiovisual Department at 702.693.7662.

Anytime an exhibit, production or decorating company is brought into the hotel, floor plans must be approved by the fire department and proof of insurance must be received. Additionally, the subcontracted company must read and sign policies and procedures prior to working at Bellagio.

Show Move-In/Move-Out

Thirty (30) days prior to a show, the Convention Services Manager will contact the convention meeting planner to review and confirm move-in and move-out times and dates.

Move-in/move-out times are between 6:00 a.m. and Midnight. The Convention Services Manager must approve any exceptions to this time frame. Prior to move-in, a representative of the group, the outside company and the Convention Services Manager will walk the area for an official inspection.

At this time, cleanliness and state of repair will be noted, and any cleaning or repairs needed will be scheduled. This is for all areas the group will be utilizing (e.g., parking lot, driveways, loading dock, service hallways, foyers, and actual exhibit area).

The show will be inspected according to the Fire Marshal-approved plan. The group prior to show opening will correct any violation.

At the conclusion of each show move-out, a representative from the group, the outside company and the Convention Services Manager will walk the show area for final inspection.

Mutually agreed upon damages caused by the group or outside company will be recorded and submitted to the Convention Services Manager who will, in turn, coordinate the repairs with the Engineering Department. All labor and materials will be billed to the group at cost. Full payment is required within 30 days of billing date.

The outside company will be responsible for leaving all areas of Bellagio in the same condition they were in prior to move-in, less normal wear and tear.

During exhibit shows, Bellagio will only be responsible for areas where the hotel has food and beverage.

Fire Marshal Regulations

One month prior to your show, Bellagio must receive Fire Marshal-approved floor plans for any work to be handled by an exhibit, production or decorating company. In addition, floor plans must be submitted by the hotel to the Fire Marshal for any functions of 300 persons or more. Therefore, it is necessary to have all audiovisual and set-up requirements for functions of 300 or more at least 45 days prior to function date.

- Clark County Fire Marshal Diagram submitted 21 days or more prior to event are subject to a \$350.00 per plan fee.
- Clark County Fire Marshal Diagram LATE submitted 20–8 days prior to event are subject to a \$500.00 per plan fee.
- Clark County Fire Marshal Diagram EXPEDITE submitted 7 days or less prior to event are subject to a \$1,000.00 per plan fee.
- Clark County Fire Marshal Diagram REVISION/CHANGE will be priced on a per case basis based on the pricing listed above.
- Clark County Fire Marshal Vehicle Permit \$100.00 (cost is in addition to established fire marshal diagram fees and covers all vehicles per program).

Floor plans are final once approved by the Fire Department. No additional equipment, tables or décor may be added. However, the Fire Department will allow deletion of equipment, tables and décor from the final floor plan. Regulations of the Clark County Fire Department Fire Prevention Bureau must be observed in their entirety. Bellagio will not be held responsible for functions that do not adhere to these policies.

Clark County Fire Department Uniform Fire Code Permit Information

Clark County Ordinance No. 2289, Title 13, Chapter 13.04— Clark County Fire Department requires that a floor plan must be submitted for approval by the Fire Inspector for every function of 300 or more people or exhibits for 50 or more attendees. Floor plans must be submitted to the Clark County Fire Department at least 21 calendar days prior to the start of the function. The cost of the fire permit will be billed to the group's master account, pending approval. Props and décor must be included on submitted floor plans.

All floor plans for functions being set up and produced by Bellagio will be submitted to the Fire Department by Bellagio.

Any floor plans submitted by an outside production or decorating company must be reviewed and authorized by a Bellagio Convention Services Manager prior to submitting.

Production or decorating companies must send a copy of the Fire Inspector-approved plan to your Convention Services Manager prior to actual move-in. Set-up will be delayed if we have not received those plans.

Bellagio will not be held responsible for functions that do not adhere to these policies.

Safety — Bellagio Convention Center

Welcome to the Bellagio Convention Center. Our goal is to provide you and your group with the premier conference experience and assist you in maximizing your experience. The following guidelines are provided to help assure the safety of your group while at Bellagio.

Fire prevention is one of our primary safety concerns. Bellagio Convention Center is equipped with a state-of-the-art fire prevention and sprinkler system with 24-hour monitor control by Bellagio personnel. In the event of a fire, call 6911 on a house phone to report the incident. In order for the system to be fully effective, it is most important that there is no interference with sprinkler heads, fire extinguishers or fire exit doors. It is also important to assure that you never block designated emergency exits and pathways with displays, stanchions, freight, or other materials. Your Convention Services Manager (CSM) must approve all displays and decorations. Mylar balloons are not allowed. All display decorations must be treated with fire retardant. Do not bring any fuels or flammable materials into the Convention Center without clearance from your CSM.

Emergency evacuation notice will be given by a whistle alarm and a flashing strobe light. Listen for voice instructions over the PA. Remain in your meeting area and evacuate if instructed to do so. Do not take escalators or elevators in an emergency evacuation. Use only the emergency stair exits. Bellagio Security will arrive on the scene to direct and assist. Follow all directions issued by Bellagio Security Officers.

Smoking

The Nevada Clean Indoor Air Act prohibits smoking in indoor public spaces. As a result, smoking is not permitted in the meeting and convention spaces. Additionally, smoking is not permitted in restaurants, lounges where food is served, hotel lobbies, elevators, guest room hallways, theaters, arenas, arcades, retail stores, or other indoor public spaces. The Casino floor and certain lounges where food is not served are exempt.

Chemicals may be brought into Bellagio Convention Center only when clearance is given by your CSM. You will need to have Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) available on site for any approved chemicals that you are bringing in to the Convention Center.

Emergency medical attention may be summoned by contacting Bellagio Security at 6911 on a house phone. Be prepared to give your location in the Bellagio Convention Center, your name and the nature of the emergency. Bellagio Security has EMS responders.

Security of your items and materials in Bellagio Convention Center remains your responsibility. While Bellagio Security and facilities control are as effective as possible, we cannot guarantee the total protection of your property. Report any suspicious conditions to Bellagio Security at 6911. For additional security, see your CSM.

Incidents that need attention, but are not an emergency, such as spills, property damage or other related conditions, should be reported to Bellagio Security at 7180.

Floor plans must be submitted to your CSM and may also require approval by the Clark County Fire Department. The final plan approved by the Fire Department must be followed. No changes can be made once the plans have been approved by the Fire Department without the additional approval of the Fire Department and your CSM.

Mechanical Lift Equipment (forklift, pallet jack, scissor lift) should be used only with clearance by your CSM. Please ask your CSM for further details.

Pyrotechnics and flame effect presentations must be presented to your CSM and approved by the Clark County Fire Department. You must arrange to have such plans submitted to the Fire Department. Operational procedures for pyrotechnics and flame effect displays must be followed according to the approved plan. Bellagio Conference Center does not have the authority to allow changes to your plans that have been approved by the Fire Department. See your CSM for additional requirements regarding pyrotechnics.
